Private candidates registered for the Alternative Paper (04/2) in the French and Spanish Unit 1 and Unit 2 examinations will not be required to take a written paper but will be required to take the oral examinations. No dates have been scheduled for the oral examinations, however, they must be taken between 14–29 April at the discretion of the Local Registrar.
4. Art and Design: The Question Papers (Papers 2 and 3 for Unit 1 and Paper 2 for Unit 2) are to be handed to candidates on Friday, 17 April. The examinations must be completed during the period 11-22 May.
5. Once scheduled in the same session, the Alternative Paper 03/2 must be written after Paper 1.
